



# Donna Parent Lewiston Porter Federal Credit Union Scholarship

The Donna Parent Lewiston Porter Federal Credit Union is a scholarship opportunity for members of the Lewiston Porter Federal Credit Union. This scholarship seeks to acknowledge outstanding academic achievement, and provide financial support for future education goals.

1. One **\$750.00 Credit Union scholarship** will be awarded each year. Additionally, **this scholarship may be renewed for \$750.00 annually for up to three additional years.** Recipients must obtain a 3.0 GPA or equivalent for continued renewal. Failure to maintain required GPA will result in disqualification for the remaining scholarship awards.
2. The scholarship is available to **members in good standing of the Credit Union.** **There is no age requirement or limitation.** Students must be enrolled full-time (12 credit hours or more) in an accredited post-secondary collegiate or vocational/technical program.
3. Applications may be obtained from the Credit Union office beginning January 1, 2024. **The deadline for the applications is April 15th, 2024.** Applications will be anonymously reviewed by the Scholarship Committee, and recommended for approval by the Credit Union Board of Trustees. The winner will be notified by May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.** (Applicants who are not high school seniors should submit a current scholastic transcript reviewing the previous four years. When this is not applicable, one additional letter of recommendation is required for students reentering academic or vocational study.)
